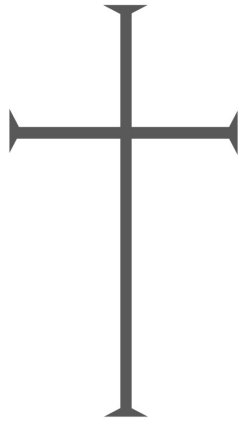


DONALD CLARK

Vancouver Island.

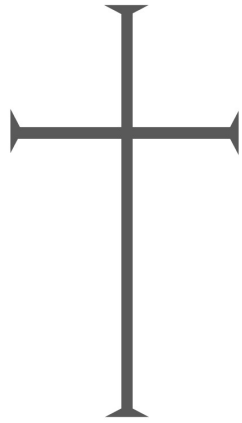


GORDON MELVILLE STEVENTON

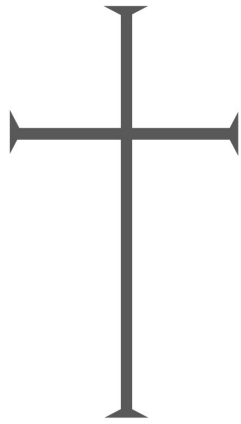


CAMPBELL ARCHIBALD

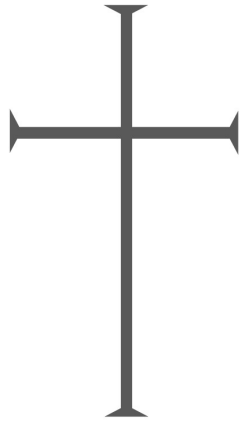
ERNEST QUARRIER

of Normandy.

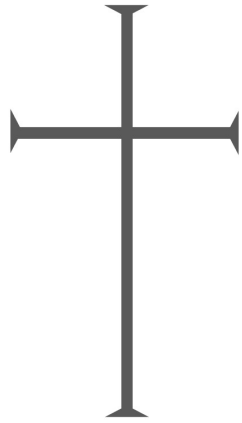


LESLIE GORDON

of Normandy.



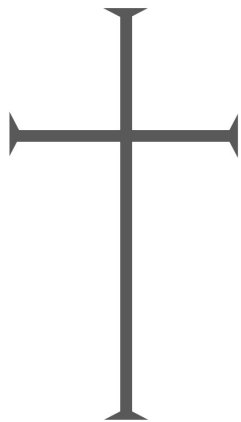
CHARLES EDWARD TINDALL

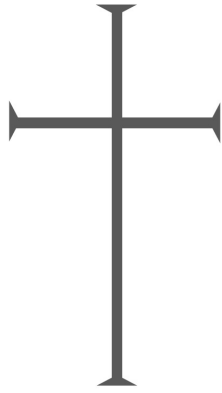


GORDON WILLIAM

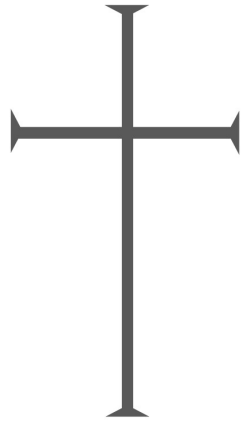


DOUGLAS C.

when I died.

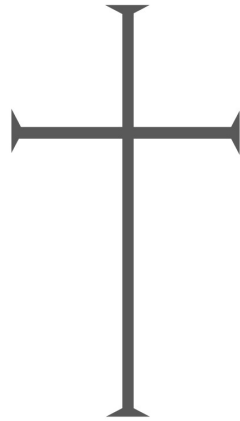


ROBERT FRANCIS

Hautes-de-Seine, France

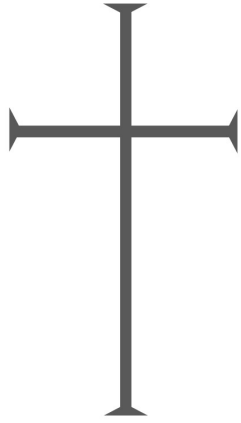

and died while in service



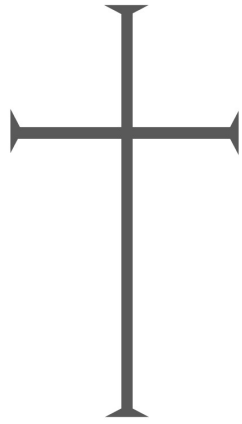
GEORGE EDWIN

killed.

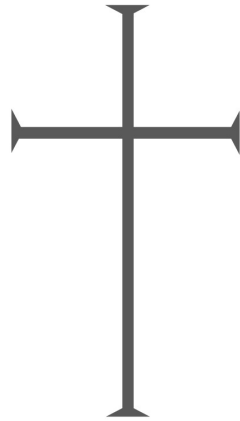


FREDERICK
