

# LENTEN RESPONSIVE READING: WEEK 3

#### Leader:

Today we lay before the cross the bag of coins, reward for treachery toward the Son of God. Judas handed Jesus over to the authorities, in greed and self-interest deliberately betraying his Lord. We are reminded of the futility of seeking to satisfy ourselves by such paths.

## People:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us. We blame Judas for his greed, his selfishness, but excuse our own. We too are grasping and self-seeking. In the shadow of Your cross we cry, "Have mercy on us."

## Leader:

While Judas sought payment for unfaithfulness, Jesus died in faithfulness. In His life and death He became the Bread broken for us, the Blood poured out for us. Jesus freely offers to all who hunger and thirst the eternal nourishment of His very self.

## People:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us. At times we too live unfaithfully. We spend our money for that which is not bread; we labour for that which does not satisfy. In the shadow of Your cross we cry, "Have mercy on us."

Leader: Let us pray together . . .

### All:
