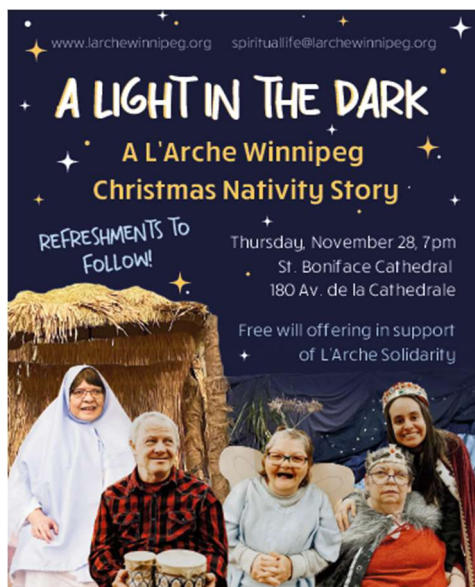




Remembrance Day
